- Direct Care Staff provided 24/7.

- DCS's goal for the children is to reunite with their biological family.
- When returning to their biological family is not possible, Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) places children with caring families in adoptive homes that are Indiana DCS licensed foster parents.
